Clinical History: chest pain.

CT THORAX done on .

Findings:

Patient is rotated with poor inspiratory effort.

Diffuse ground glass opacities seen at bilateral mid zone, lower zone with peripheral predominant.

Patchy consolidation seen at bilateral lower zone, perihilar obscuring left heart border.

Increase interstitial shadowing seen at bilateral lower zone .

No pleural effusion. Apparent cardiomegaly.

No mediastinal widening.

Visualised osseous and soft tissues are unremarkable

Features are suggestive of lung infection.
